YMCA Storer Camps offers Camp Catch-A-Rainbow (CCAR) for children who have had a cancer diagnosis at any point in their lives. These free programs allow children to have a “normal” camping experience complete with swimming, horseback riding, sports, new friendships, and much more!

Camp Catch-A-Rainbow is currently seeking volunteers to help provide children with an unforgettable summer. Both medical and general volunteers are needed for this upcoming summer.

Medical volunteers assure all camper health needs are met through the week by traveling around with an assigned group of 4-10 campers. Example responsibilities include administering medication and basic first aid. Medical volunteers must hold a medical license in the state of Michigan and be one of the following: RN, NP, APNP, CNP, PA, DO, MD.

General volunteers may serve a variety of roles including cabin counselor, one-on-one camper assignments and logistical assistance. Preference is given to applicants 21 years of age and older, although those younger with camping experience are encouraged to apply.
