## Camp Catch-A-Rainbow: Free Pediatric Oncology Camp YMCA STORER CAMPS

YMCA Storer Camps in Jackson, MI offers programs to enrich the lives of children who are being treated for cancer or who are in remission from cancer. These programs are operated at no-cost to the campers and funded through generous donations. Camp Catch-A-Rainbow (CCAR) programs allow children who have had a cancer diagnosis to have a "normal" camping experience complete with swimming, sports, horseback riding, boating, new friendships, and much more! Pediatric oncology professionals are available 24 hours a day to monitor each child's special needs. The medical staff administer general medications and chemotherapy as needed, take blood counts and coordinate special dietary considerations.

#### **Overnight Camp**

A one-week program for children ages 7-15. A mix of traditional summer camp activities plus special programs and surprise guests from **August 2 - August 7, 2020.** 

#### Young Camper's Day

A program for children ages 4-6 that takes all of Overnight Camp and packs it into one day on **August 2, 2020.** 

#### Leader-in-Training

A one-week program for children ages 16 & 17. Participants will gain leadership skills through a planned curriculum and opportunities to develop program activities. The LIT program runs along side of Overnight Camp from **August 2 - August 7, 2020.**
