Guidelines for Hiring Summer Staff at YMCA Storer Camps

Please read the following before applying:

- You MUST be 18 by June 1st of this year and have spent a year out of high school. High School graduate preferred.
- Be available to work from early June through 1st week of August
- Must have a strong desire to work with children.
- Have a current CPR/First Aid certification or be willing to obtain them prior to staff training.
- Understand that smoking, drugs and alcohol are not allowed anywhere on camp property.
- Understand employee is regularly required to sit, stand and walk for long periods, lift and/or move up to 50 lbs, and clean the facility.
- Follow dress code established by YMCA Storer Camps.
- Understand that this is mostly a residential position which involves living at camp in cabins with campers. Campers range from ages 7-17.
- Background checks are required
- Make sure certifications are up to date if required, e.g. life guard, CPR and high ropes certification.
- Work to fulfill the mission of the YMCA of Greater Toledo: To put Christian principles into practice through programs that build a healthy, spirit, mind and body for all.
