Camp Catch-A-Rainbow (CCAR) programs allow children who have had a cancer diagnosis to have a “normal” camping experience complete with swimming, sports, horseback riding, boating, new friendships, and much more! Pediatric hematology/oncology professionals are available 24 hours a day to monitor each child’s special needs. The medical staff administer general medications and chemotherapy as needed, take blood counts and coordinate special dietary considerations.
