Camp Catch-A-Rainbow: Free Pediatric Oncology Camp YMCA STORER CAMPS

Medical and General Volunteers Needed!

YMCA Storer Camps offers Camp Catch-A-Rainbow (CCAR) and Young Camper's Day (YCD) for young cancer survivors from Michigan, Ohio, and Indiana. These free camps allow children who have had a cancer diagnosis to have a "normal" camping experience complete with swimming, horseback riding, boating, sports, new friendships, and much more!

Staffed by volunteers, Camp Catch-A-Rainbow programs offer campers 24 hour access to health care professionals to meet their cancer care needs. Medical Professionals (licensed in MI) are currently needed to act as volunteer cabin counselors to help meet the medical care needs of participants.

General Cabin Counselors (MALE volunteers especially) and Arts & Crafts volunteers are needed as well. Preference is given to those 21 or older, but those at least 18 with one year of college or work experience post high school may be considered.
